Traffic signal work at Illinois 40/U.S. 150 begins May 10

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that lane closures in both directions of Illinois 40 (Knoxville Avenue) at U.S. 150 (War Memorial Drive) begin May 10.

The closures are necessary for traffic signal work at the intersection and will run from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. through May 14. The closures will primarily be in the right turn lanes but will vary throughout the week. All directions of travel will remain accessible.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
