## **Illinois 9 in Bushnell to close May 10** *Railroad crossing work to last a week*

**BUSHNELL** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that Illinois 9 (Ludwig Street) between Sperry Street and Illinois 41 (Green Street) will close at 8 a.m. May 10.

The closure is necessary for BNSF Railway to make repairs to the railroad crossing. A detour will be posted during the work, which is expected to last about a week.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
