## **Closures at I-74 ramp and U.S. 34 set May 23**

*Steel girder replacement on bridge just west of I-74/U.S. 34 interchange*

**GALESBURG** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that lane closures on westbound U.S. 34 at the Farnham Street bridge will be closed from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. May 23. The ramps from Interstate 74 to westbound U.S. 34 also will be closed.

The closures are necessary to remove and replace steel girders on the bridge, located a half-mile west of the I-74/U.S. 34 interchange. A detour will be posted.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
