I-80 pavement patching in Geneseo begins May 24

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that weather permitting, pavement patching in the eastbound lanes of Interstate 80 at the Illinois 82 interchange (exit 19) in Geneseo in Henry County will begin at 7 a.m. Monday, May 24.

One eastbound lane of traffic will be maintained throughout the project, which is expected to be completed by Wednesday, May 26.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
