Overnight Ramp Closure on Kennedy for Halsted Street Project

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that closures on Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90/94) will be taking place this weekend, weather permitting, for the ongoing construction of the new Halsted Street bridge, part of the larger reconstruction of the Jane Byrne Interchange.

The following closures are scheduled:

- **Inbound Kennedy Expressway** – The right lane from Jackson Boulevard to the Eisenhower Expressway (Interstate 290) will be closed between 1 and 8 a.m. Saturday and between 1 and 6 a.m. Sunday.

The ramp from the inbound Kennedy to the outbound Eisenhower will be closed during these times. A detour route will be posted, directing traffic to the outbound Dan Ryan Expressway (Interstate 90/94) and the 18th Street interchange to access the outbound Eisenhower via the inbound Dan Ryan.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
