US 45 Resurfacing Project to begin in Mokena and Frankfort

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a resurfacing project will begin along US 45 between Birch Avenue and Colorado Avenue in Mokena and Frankfort, weather permitting, Monday, April 20. Planned work on project includes pavement patching, milling of existing surface and placement of new hot mix asphalt surface course.

In order to complete the work, lane reductions will occur but change day to day.

The project is slated to be complete by July 17.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
