## **Lane Reductions on U.S. 20 in Hanover Park**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will take place on U.S. 20 (West Lake Street), between Bear Flag Drive/Ontarioville Road and Greenbrook Boulevard., in Hanover Park, for traffic signal improvement, the addition of turn lanes, entrance ramp improvement, pavement patching and storm sewer replacement, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Sept. 28.

In order to complete the work, traffic lanes will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes in each direction. Additionally, storm sewer pipe installation and pavement patching will require additional, occasional lane closures.

The project will be complete by May 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
