IL Route 127 in Clinton County

Location – IL 127 Structure over Kaskaskia River south of Carlyle, IL

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that beginning on April 28, 2014 at 7:00 a.m., the IL Route 127 structure over the Kaskaskia River will be closed 2.5 miles south of Carlyle. The road closure is required to replace the structure over the Kaskaskia River. This work is expected to be completed and IL 127 reopened to traffic by October 2014. A marked detour route utilizing Slant Road and IL Route 161 will be in place. The Department suggests the travelling public follow detour signs and drive with caution. The contractor on this project is Sangamo Construction Company of Springfield, IL.
