- An emergency involving public health.
- An emergency involving public safety.
- Necessary to protect State property from further loss or damage.
- Necessary to prevent or minimize serious disruption in State services.
- Necessary to insure integrity of State records.
- Quick purchase as provided by Section 20-30 (d) of the Illinois Procurement Code.

The conditions and circumstances requiring this emergency expenditure are:

Extensive flooding of the Illinois River eroded the pavement and west shoulder of IL Route 351 from north of the Shippingsport Bridge toward the City of LaSalle for approximately 1/2 mile. The rains that began on April 17, 2013 caused the closure of IL 351 at approximately 4 AM on Friday, April 19, 2013. Roadway damage was noted on Sunday with the extent being more fully realized as the water receded. The damage requires IL Route 351 to be closed until repairs can be made. The Scope of work will be to rebuild the bituminous shoulder and to remove and replace delaminated asphalt surface. The Department has selected Advanced Asphalt Company to preform the work. They are a very experienced Contractor that does this work in District 3, they are the only contractor in the area with an activated asphalt palnt.
