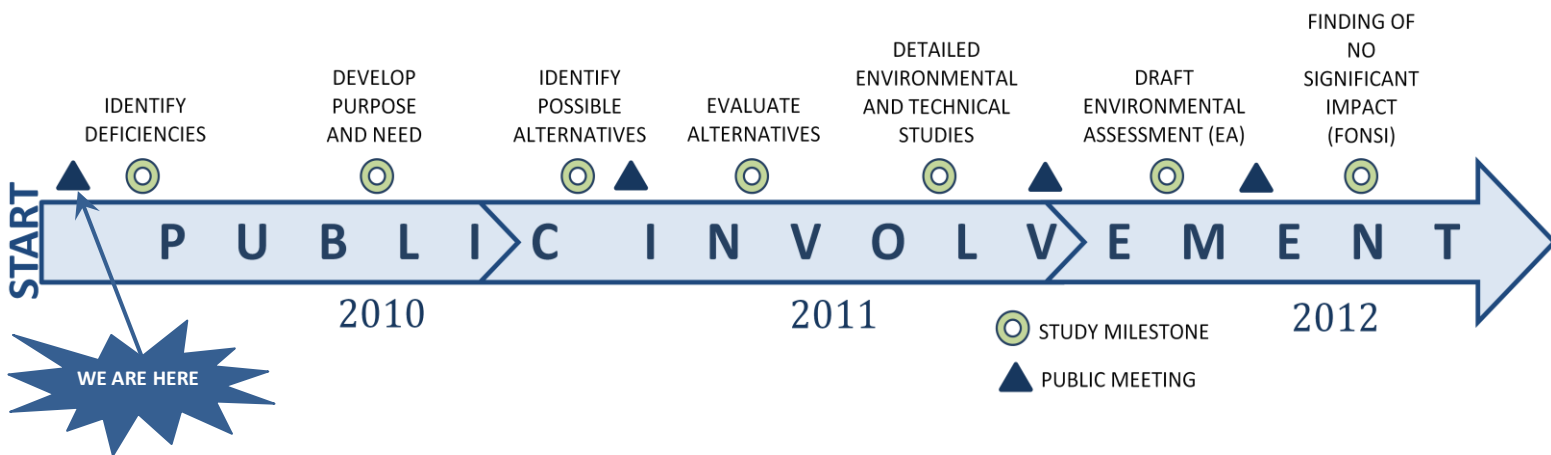

- Determination of the **Purpose and Need** of the **Proposed Action**.
- Defining the **Affected Environment**.
- Development of a **Range of Alternatives** to the proposed action.
- **Analysis** of the environmental impacts of each of the possible alternatives

The first step in the study process is defining the transportation problem, assessing community issues, and determining the community context. You will be requested to participate in a survey to gather information on community related issues - the Community Context Survey. We encourage your participation in this survey; the information collected will directly influence decisions made on this project.
