[Public Act 90-287](#) (HB 489) effective January 1, 1998 allows local agencies to adopt ordinances which permit all-terrain vehicles to operate on roads and /or bridges under their jurisdiction in order to access areas designated for use by such vehicles. This act also required the Department to adopt signs to be used by local agencies to mark such routes.

Attached are details for a sign to mark ATV routes and a warning sign to be used, as necessary, to warn of ATV route crossings or where ATV's must cross a bridge or other structure. These signs will be included in the future revision of the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. However, these signs are currently official traffic control devices and may be used at any time.


