Allocation of STR Funds to the Counties

COUNTY ENGINEERS/SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

Attached is a list of the FFY 02 Surface Transportation Program Rural (STR) allocations for the downstate 96 counties. The total amount of FFY 02 STR funds allocated to the counties is \$28,870,267 with \$25,749,590 to be distributed among the counties in Districts 2 through 9.

The formula for distribution of the STR funds to the downstate counties is as follows:

1. Ten percent divided equally among the downstate counties, Districts 2-9.
2. Balance allocated to the downstate counties on the basis of the following three factors with equal weight being given to each factor:
 - a. non-urban area
 - b. non-urban population
 - c. non-urban mileage (total all systems)

This year's distribution reflects the 2000 census and the 2000 Illinois Highway and Street Mileage Statistics non-urban mileage population totals. The non-urban area factor was not revised this year. New 2000 census urban areas will be released later this year and will be utilized in next year's distribution.

Distribution of the \$4 million of state matching funds is still being finalized. You will be advised of the allocation of state matching funds by separate letter.
