

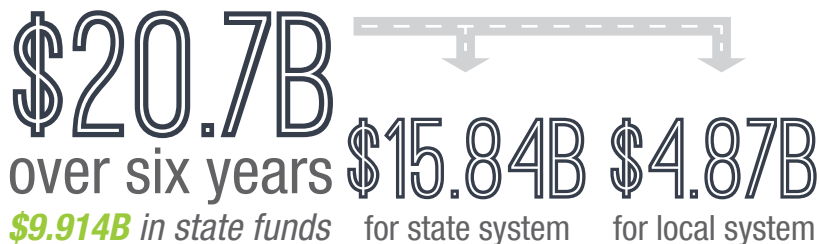

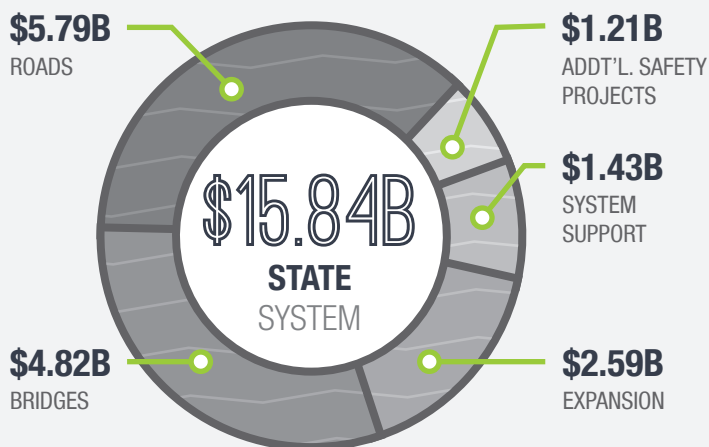
REBUILDING OUR MYP

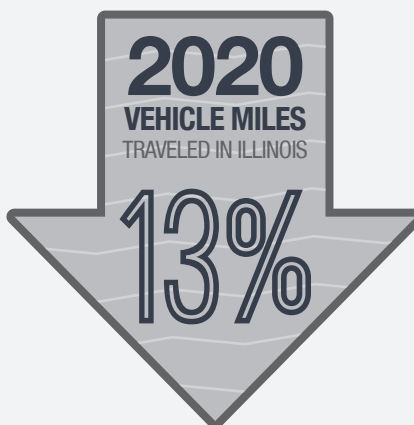

IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



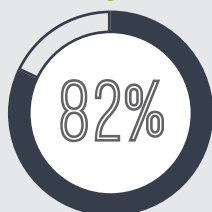
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

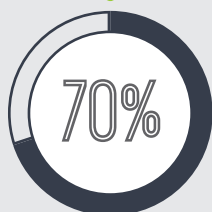

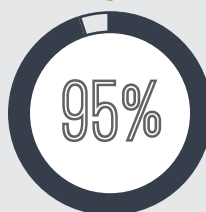


NON-INTERSTATES

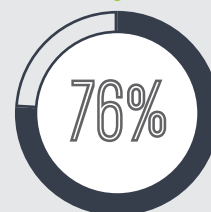


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COLES

- **I-57:** \$31.2 million for two bridge replacements and reconstruction of Illinois 16 interchange east of Mattoon.

CUMBERLAND

- **I-57:** \$18.4 million to replace four bridges and additional improvements at Eastern Illinois Railroad south of Neoga interchange and U.S. 45 at Neoga.

EFFINGHAM

- **I-70:** \$50.5 million for rubblization of 6.9 miles, ramp repairs of 0.9 miles, bridge repairs and culvert rehabilitation east of the Interstate 57 interchange to the Cumberland County line.
- **U.S. 40/Illinois 33/Fayette Avenue:** \$44.6 million for reconstruction and additional lanes of 1.5 miles, ADA improvements, and curb, gutter and storm sewer from Raney Street to Long Street in Effingham.
- **I-70:** \$14.6 million for reconstructing 1 mile, bridge superstructure replacement, bridge removal and bridge raising at Altamont interchange to 0.8 miles east.

MOULTRIE

- **Illinois 121:** \$10.4 million for resurfacing 13.7 miles and ADA improvements from Dalton City to Eastlawn Drive in Sullivan.

MACON

- **I-72:** \$59.9 million for resurfacing 19.6 miles and two bridge replacements from the Sangamon County line to west of U.S. 51 at Forsyth.
- **Old U.S. 51 Business:** \$9 million for resurfacing 4.3 miles and ADA improvements from Illinois 121 to U.S. 36 in Decatur.
