

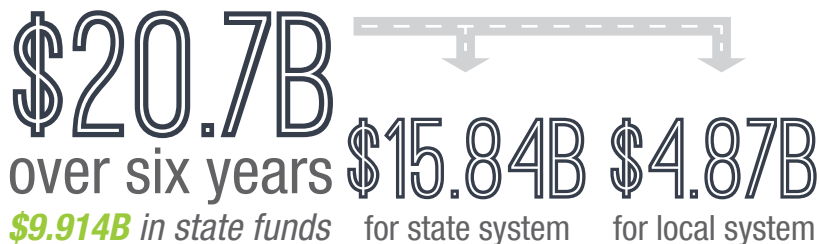

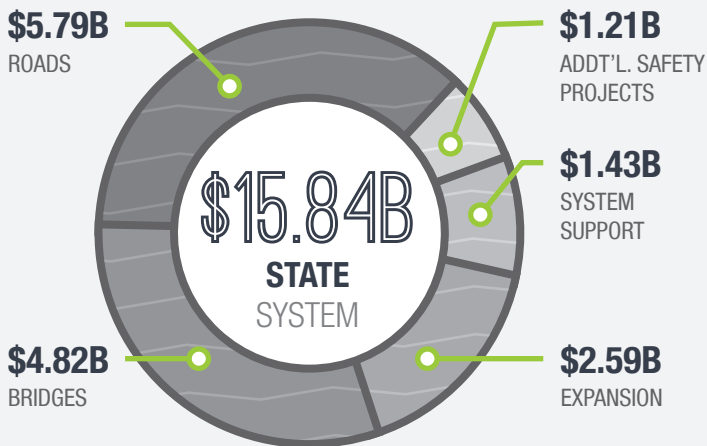
REBUILDING OUR MYP

IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES



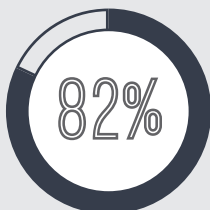
Due to the pandemic, **vehicle miles traveled in Illinois dropped by 13%** in 2020.

The decrease in motor fuel tax revenues was largely offset by federal COVID-19 relief, **preserving projects in the MYP.**

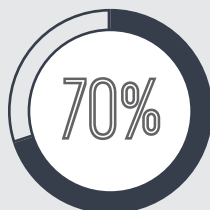

INTERSTATES

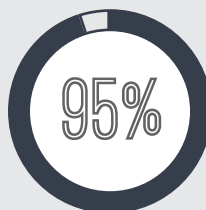


NON-INTERSTATES

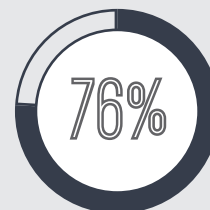


STATE BRIDGES IN ACCEPTABLE CONDITION

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

GREENE

- **U.S. 67:** \$20.1 million for bridge replacement over Apple Creek Overflow, 3.5 miles south of White Hall.

MADISON

- **I-270 over Mississippi River:** \$257.6 million for a bridge replacement. Shared project with Missouri replaces structure built in 1966 that handles 51,000 vehicles a day, 17% of which are trucks.
- **Illinois 162/157:** \$22 million for intersection relocation and reconstruction, as well as a bridge replacement at Illinois 157.

MARION

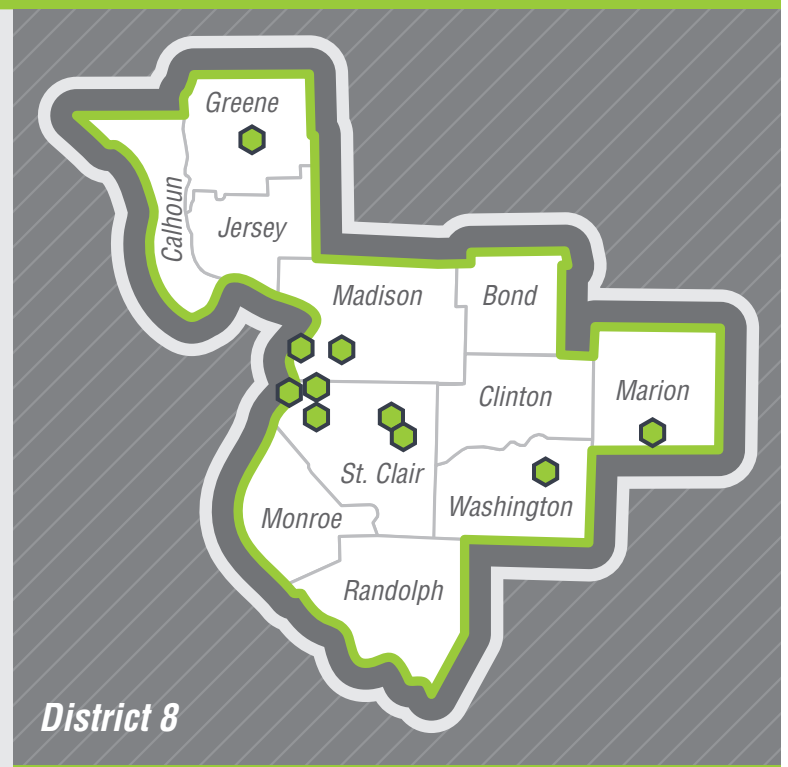
- **I-57:** \$39 million for reconstruction of 4.9 miles (including ramp repair) and bridge repairs/improvements from Jefferson County line to 0.7 mile north of Illinois 161.

ST. CLAIR

- **I-55/I-64/U.S. 40/Illinois 3:** \$188.5 million for reconstruction and bridge improvements from Mississippi River to I-64.
- **I-255/U.S. 50:** \$148.8 million to resurface 22.3 miles (including ramp repair) from Illinois 3 to Illinois 15 and repairs to the Jefferson Barracks Bridge.
- **Illinois 3 Connector:** \$81.5 million to improve traffic flow, connectivity and access between East St. Louis, Fairmont City and Madison.
- **I-64 from Greenmount Road to west of Illinois 158:** \$35.6 million for additional lanes and bridge repairs.
- **Illinois 158:** \$17.7 million for new construction of 1.2 miles, new bridge, new culvert that relocates Illinois 158 from Illinois 177 to Illinois 161.

WASHINGTON

- **I-64:** \$46.5 million for resurfacing and bridge repairs west of Beaver Pond Creek to west of County Highway 11.
